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#### **SECTION A – TECHNICAL INFORMATION**

#### 1 INTRODUCTION

The Council for Scientific and Industrial Research (CSIR) is one of the leading scientific research and technology development organisations in Africa. In partnership with national and international research and technology institutions, CSIR undertakes directed and multidisciplinary research and technology innovation that contributes to the improvement of the quality of life of South Africans. The CSIR's main site is in Pretoria while it is represented in other provinces of South Africa through regional offices. An expression of interest (EOI) is required in order to establish a pool of suitable pre-qualified experts to partner with in some future mining related research projects. The availabilities of the experts to perform the task will be established and their acceptance of a fixed service fee is confirmed, within a limited period, to provide specified services as part of future proposals.

#### 2 BACKGROUND

The CSIR Mining Cluster provides mining related contract research and consulting in areas such as mechanical engineering, failure investigation of mechanical components and systems, mining occupational health and safety, mine emergency response and rescue and mine environmental engineering, to customers in the public and private sectors. The objective of this invitation process is to solicit information to enable the CSIR to establish a pool of suitable pre-qualified experts to partner with in some future mining related research projects.

#### 3 INVITATION FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

Expressions of interest are hereby invited from suitable-qualified service providers to partner with in possible future research projects, on terms and conditions acceptable to the CSIR.

#### 4 EOI SPECIFICATIONS (OVERVIEW OF REQUIREMENTS)

The experts will be required in the following areas:

- 1. Occupational health and safety (OHS) and OHS risk management
- 2. Mine environmental / ventilation Engineering
- 3. Dust control / suppression
- 4. Emergency response and rescue in mines

- 5. Occupational hygiene (including but not limited to practitioners appointed in terms of Section 12.1 of the Mine Health and Safety Act)
- 6. Occupational Medicine
- 7. Applied physiology, including laboratory stress testing of human subjects
- 8. Design, manufacture, evaluation and testing of emergency breathing apparatus
- 9. Mechanical Engineering design
- 10. Mechanical testing
- 11. Failure investigation of mechanical systems and components
- 12. Mine fire and explosion prevention and control
- 13. Underground and surface rock engineering expertise
- 14. Underground and surface mining engineering expertise
- 15. Underground and surface geology expertise
- 16. Change management and industrial psychology expertise

- 6.3 Proposals with functionality / technical points of less than the pre-determined minimum overall percentage of 50% will be eliminated from further evaluation.

10.1 All expressions of interest are to be sealed. No open expression of interest will be accepted.

10.2 All expressions of interest are to be clearly marked with the EOI number,

10.3 Responses submitted by companies must be signed by a person or persons duly authorised.

#### 11 DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSION

Expression of interest shall be submitted at the address mentioned above no later than the closing date of **22 June 2021** during CSIR's business hours. The CSIR business hours are between 08h00 and 16h30.

Where an EOI is not received by the CSIR by the due date and stipulated place, it will be regarded as a late EOI. Late EOI's will not be considered.

#### 12 EVALUATION PROCESS

The EOI evaluation process will include a functionality/technical evaluation. No price evaluation will be done at this stage.

#### 13 ENQUIRIES AND CONTACT WITH THE CSIR

#### 14 MEDIUM OF COMMUNICATION

All documentation submitted in response to this Expression of Interest must be in English.

#### 15 COST OF EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

Companies are expected to fully acquaint themselves with the conditions, requirements and specifications of this EOI before submitting responses. Each service provider assumes all risks for resource commitment and expenses, direct or indirect, of EOI preparation and participation throughout the EOI process. The CSIR is not responsible directly or indirectly for any costs incurred by Companies.

#### 16 CORRECTNESS OF RESPONSES

16.1 The service provider must confirm satisfaction regarding the correctness and validity of their EOI.

#### 17 VERIFICATION OF DOCUMENTS

- 17.1 Companies should check the numbers of the pages to satisfy themselves that none are missing or duplicated. No liability will be accepted by the CSIR in regard to anything arising from the fact that pages are missing or duplicated.
- 17.2 One electronic copy of each EOI must be submitted.

#### 18 ENGAGEMENT OF CONSULTANTS

All potential Companies need to note that consultants will only be remunerated at the rates:

- 18.1 Determined in the "Guideline for fees", issued by the South African Institute of Chartered Accountants (SAICA); or
- 18.2 Set out in the "Guide on Hourly Fee Rates for Consultants", by the Department of Public Service and Administration (DPSA); or
- 18.3 As prescribed by the body regulating the profession of the consultant.

#### 19 TRAVEL EXPENSES
