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SECTION A - TECHNICAL INFORMATION

1 INTRODUCTION

The Council for Scientific and Industrial Research (CSIR) is a leading scientific research and technology development organisation in Africa. In partnership with national and international partners, CSIR undertakes directed and multidisciplinary research and technology innovation that contribute to the improvement of the quality of life of South Africans and the world at large. The CSIR's main site is in Pretoria while it is represented in other provinces of South Africa through regional offices.

2 BACKGROUND

The Radar and Electronic Warfare (REW) Impact Area annually executes a number of projects that require "Flight Services" from time to time from a suitable aircraft company that can supply an airworthy and well-maintained Cessna 208B aircraft as well as a suitably qualified pilot to operate the Cessna 208B aircraft with an open door with the CSIR's airborne SAR facility installed and operated onboard.

The CSIR's Airborne SAR facility is being certified for airworthiness to be installed and operated onboard a Cessna 208B aircraft for experimental R&D measurement campaigns.

In order to simplify the procurement of Flight Services, the CSIR would like to have a suitable supplier available who is pre-contracted. This supplier would be required to have a pilot available that has the required qualifications and necessary experience and skills to perform experimental R&D type flight trials with a Cessna 208B aircraft, as well as have the required Cessna 208B Aircraft available to deliver the services to CSIR requirements.

3 INVITATION FOR PROPOSAL

Proposals are hereby invited from suppliers that have a proven track record for the supply of the following Services:

- 1. Provision of a well maintained and airworthy Cessna 208B Aircraft for the duration of a specific flight trial operating from Wonderboom Airport, or other airport close to Pretoria.
- 2. Provision of technician(s) to assist with:

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- a. the safe installation of the CSIR's airborne SAR Facility onboard the Cessna 208B Aircraft.
- b. safe attachment / mounting of the SAR Facility's GPS antennas,
- c. removal of the cargo door,
- d. fitting a wind deflector,
- e. moving / removing / installing any seats required by the CSIR
- f. removing the CSIR's airborne SAR facility after a flight trial.
- Provision of an experienced and qualified Test Pilot that is certified to fly the Cessna 208B aircraft for the duration of the experimental R&D trial.
- 4. If required by the CSIR, the provision of an experienced and qualified pilot to be the co-pilot during the Flights.
- 5. The operator will ensure that all required and applicable safety precautions and procedures will be followed to ensure safety of own and CSIR personnel.

Note: At least one CSIR Engineer/Technician are required to fly with the SAR Airborne facility to operate the facility during the measurement campaign.

4 PROPOSAL SPECIFICATIONS

All proposals are to be submitted in a format the tenderers deem fit.

The proposal to be submitted will be based on an average hourly rate for indicated tasks. This hourly rate serves as guideline to the CSIR.

A contract will be entered into with the successful supplier(s) for a maximum number of hours or celling price, but tasks will be contracted with the selected and contracted supplier(s) on an Ad Hoc basis as the need for experimental flight trials develop. Such flights will be booked at least two weeks in advance to allow scheduling according to the availability of aircraft and test pilot as well as the CSIR team.

4.1 Technical Proposal

The following must be submitted as part of the technical proposal:

· Covering letter;

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- Proposal for the provision of Flight Services and motivation why the company is suitable to provide the requested Flight Services with the CSIR's Airborne SAR Facility installed onboard a Cessna 208B.
- Company profile clearly stipulating:
 - Main areas of business and expertise;
 - Aircraft Ownership (If any)
- Proof of airworthiness certification for the aircraft.
- CV of Test Pilot(s) indicating qualifications and experience.
- In the case where the supplier does not own the aircraft, a letter from the owner of the aircraft is required indicating permission for the use of such aircraft for experimental R&D flight trials with the CSIR's airborne SAR Facility as per suppliers proposal.
- References

4.2 Financial Proposal

The following must be submitted as part of the financial proposal:

- Proposed cost/ commercial offer on official company letterhead.
- The pricing must be firm and inclusive of all costs and disbursements required to render the required services to the CSIR.
- Average hourly rate for specified tasks.
- Provide a valid original or certified copy of B-BBEE certificate or valid sworn affidavit.

5 FUNCTIONAL EVALUATION CRITERIA

- **5.1** Refer to Annexure A for the evaluation and scoring criteria used in this process.
- **5.2** Proposals with functionality / technical points of less than the pre-determined minimum overall percentage of 70% will be eliminated from further evaluation.

6 ELIMINATION CRITERIA

Proposals will be eliminated under the following conditions:

- Submission after the deadline;
- Proposals submitted at incorrect location (Bids must be submitted electronically at tender@csir.co.za);
- Suppliers listed on National Treasury list of restricted suppliers

Notes to Pricing:

Bidders are to note that if the price offered by the highest scoring bidder is not market related, CSIR may not award the contract to that bidder. CSIR may:

- negotiate a market-related price with the Respondent scoring the highest points or cancel the RFP;
- if that bidder does not agree to a market-related price, negotiate a market-related price with the bidder scoring the second highest points or cancel the RFP;
- if the bidder scoring the second highest points does not agree to a market-related price, negotiate a market-related price with the bidder scoring the third highest points or cancel the RFP.
- If a market-related price is not agreed with the bidder scoring the third highest points, CSIR may cancel the RFP.

NB: The above cost must be inclusive of all costs required to render the required services as per above scope of work;

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9 NATIONAL TREASURY CENTRAL SUPPLIER DATABASE REGISTRATION

Before any negotiations will start with the winning bidder it will be required from the winning bidder to:

- be registered on National Treasury's Central Supplier Database (CSD). Registrations can be completed online at: www.csd.gov.za;
- provide the CSIR of their CSD registration number; and
- provide the CSIR with a certified copy of their B-BBEE certificate. If no certificate can be provided, no points will be scored during the evaluation process. (RSA suppliers only)

10 PROCEDURE FOR SUBMISSION OF PROPOSALS

- 10.1 All proposals must be submitted electronically to tender@csir.co.za.
- **10.2** Respondents must use the RFP number as the subject reference number when submitting their bids.
- **10.3** The e-mail and file sizes should not exceed a total of 25MB per e-mail.
- **10.4** The naming/labeling syntax of files or documents must be short and simple (e.g., Product Catalogues).
- **10.5** All documents submitted electronically via e-mail must be clear and visible.
- **10.6** All proposals, documents, and late submissions after the due date will not be evaluated.

12 SUBMISSION OF PROPOSALS

- **12.1** All proposals are to be submitted electronically to **tender@csir.co.za**. No late proposals will be accepted.
- **12.2** Responses submitted by companies must be signed by a person or persons duly authorised.
- **12.3** All e-mailed proposal submissions are to be clearly subject referenced with the RFP number. Proposals must consist of two parts, each of which must be sent in two separate e-mails with the following subject:
 - PART 1: Technical Proposal RFP No: 971/02/11/2021
 - PART 2: Pricing Proposal RFP No: 971/02/11/2021

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- **12.4** The CSIR will award the contract to qualified tenderer(s)' whose proposal is determined to be the most advantageous to the CSIR, taking into consideration the technical (functional) solution, price, and B-BBEE.
- **12.5** Proposals submitted must be in the following file formats:

13 DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSION

- **13.1** Proposals shall be submitted at <u>tender@csir.co.za</u> no later than the closing date of **02/11/2021** at **16h30**. The CSIR business hours are between 08h00 and 16h30.
- **13.2** Where a proposal is not received by the CSIR by the due date and stipulated e-mail address, it will be regarded as a late submission. Late submissions will not be considered.

14 AWARDING OF TENDERS

14.1 Awarding of tenders will be published on the CSIR website. No regret letters will be sent out.

15 EVALUATION PROCESS

15.1 Evaluation of proposals

An evaluation team will evaluate all proposals for functionality, price, and B-BBEE. Based on the results of the evaluation process and upon successful negotiations, the CSIR will approve the awarding of the contract to successful tenderer/s.

A two-phase evaluation process will be followed:

- 15.2 The first phase includes evaluation of elimination and functionality criteria,
- **15.3** The second phase includes the evaluation of price and B-BBEE status.

Pricing Proposals will only be considered after functionality phase has been adjudicated and accepted. Only proposals that achieved the specified minimum qualification scores for functionality will be evaluated further using the preference points system

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15.4 Preference points system

The 80/20 preference point system will be used where 80 points will be dedicated to pricing and 20 points to B-BBEE status. If all tenders received are more than R50m, the proposal will be cancelled and re-issued.

16 PRICING PROPOSAL

- 16.1 Pricing proposal must be cross-referenced to the sections in the Technical Proposal. Any options offered must be clearly labelled. Separate pricing must be provided for each option offered to ensure that pricing comparisons are clear and unambiguous.
- **16.2** Price needs to be provided in South African Rand (excl. VAT), with details on price elements that are subject to escalation and exchange rate fluctuations clearly indicated.
- **16.3** Price should include additional cost elements such as freight, insurance until acceptance, duty where applicable.
- **16.4** Only firm prices* will be accepted during the tender validity period. Non–firm prices** (including prices subject to rates of exchange variations) will not be considered.
 - *Firm price is the price that is only subject to adjustments in accordance with the actual increase or decrease resulting from the change, imposition, or abolition of customs or excise duty and any other duty, levy, or tax which, in terms of a law or regulation is binding on the contractor and demonstrably has an influence on the price of any supplies, or the rendering costs of any service, for the execution of the contract.
 - **Non-firm price is all prices other than "firm" prices.
- **16.5** Bidders must quote as per the pricing schedule.
- **16.6** Payment will be according to the CSIR Payment Terms and Conditions.

17 VALIDITY PERIOD OF PROPOSAL

17.1 Each proposal shall be valid for a minimum period of Three (3) months calculated from the closing date.

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18 APPOINTMENT OF SERVICE PROVIDER

- **18.1** The contract will be awarded to the tenderer who scores the highest total number of points during the evaluation process, except where the law permits otherwise.
- **18.2** Appointment as a successful service provider shall be subject to the parties agreeing to mutually acceptable contractual terms and conditions. In the event of the parties failing to reach such agreement CSIR reserves the right to appoint an alternative supplier.
- **18.3** Awarding of contracts will be announced on the National Treasury website and no regret letters will be sent to unsuccessful bidders.

19 ENQUIRIES AND CONTACT WITH THE CSIR

Any enquiry regarding this tender shall be submitted in writing to CSIR at tender@csir.co.za with RFP 971/02/11/2021 as the subject.

Any other contact with CSIR personnel involved in this tender is not permitted during the RFP process other than as required through existing service arrangements or as requested by the CSIR as part of the RFP process.

20 MEDIUM OF COMMUNICATION

All documentation submitted in response to this RFP must be in English.

21 COST OF PROPOSAL

Tenderers are expected to fully acquaint themselves with the conditions, requirements and specifications of this RFP before submitting proposals. Each tenderer assumes all risks for resource commitment and expenses, direct or indirect, of proposal preparation and participation throughout the RFP process. The CSIR is not responsible directly or indirectly for any costs incurred by tenderers.

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22 CORRECTNESS OF RESPONSES

- **22.1** The tenderer must confirm satisfaction regarding the correctness and validity of their proposal and that all prices and rates quoted cover all the work/items specified in the RFP. The prices and rates quoted must cover all obligations under any resulting contract.
- **22.2** The tenderer accepts that any mistakes regarding prices and calculations will be at their own risk.

23 VERIFICATION OF DOCUMENTS

- **23.1** Tenderers should check the numbers of the pages to satisfy themselves that none are missing or duplicated. No liability will be accepted by the CSIR in regard to anything arising from the fact that pages are missing or duplicated.
- 23.2 Only one electronic copy of the proposal (Technical and Financial) must be submitted via e-mail to <u>tender@csir.co.za</u>. If the bidder sends more than one proposal, the first submission shall take precedence should it not have been recalled/withdrawn in writing by the bidder.
- **23.3** Pricing schedule and B-BBEE credentials should be submitted with the proposal, but as a separate document and no such information should be available in the technical proposal.

24 SUB-CONTRACTING

- 24.1 A tenderer will not be awarded points for B-BBEE status level if it is indicated in the tender documents that such a tenderer intends sub-contracting more than 25% of the value of the contract to any other enterprise that does not qualify for at least the points that such a tenderer qualifies for, unless the intended sub-contractor is an exempted micro enterprise that has the capability and ability to execute the sub-contract.
- 24.2 A tenderer awarded a contract may not sub-contract more than 25% of the value of the contract to any other enterprise that does not have an equal or higher B-BBEE status level than the person concerned, unless the contract is sub-contracted to an exempted micro enterprise that has the capability and ability to execute the sub-contract.

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25 ADDITIONAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- **25.1** A tenderer shall not assume that information and/or documents supplied to CSIR, at any time prior to this request, are still available to CSIR, and shall consequently not make any reference to such information document in its response to this request.
- **25.2** Copies of any affiliations, memberships and/or accreditations that support your submission must be included in the tender.
- **25.3** In case of proposal from a joint venture, the following must be submitted together with the proposal:
 - Joint venture Agreement including split of work signed by both parties;
 - The original or certified copy of the B-BBEE certificate of the joint venture;
 - The Tax Clearance Certificate of each joint venture member;
 - Proof of ownership/shareholder certificates/copies; and
 - Company registration certificates.
- **25.4** An omission to disclose material information, a factual inaccuracy, and/or a misrepresentation of fact may result in the disqualification of a tender, or cancellation of any subsequent contract.
- **25.5** Failure to comply with any of the terms and conditions as set out in this document will invalidate the Proposal.

26 CSIR RESERVES THE RIGHT TO

- **26.1** Extend the closing date;
- **26.2** Verify any information contained in a proposal;
- **26.3** Request documentary proof regarding any tendering issue;
- **26.4** Give preference to locally manufactured goods;
- **26.5** Appoint one or more service providers, separately or jointly (whether or not they submitted a joint proposal);
- **26.6** Award this RFP as a whole or in part;
- **26.7** Cancel or withdraw this RFP as a whole or in part.

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27 DISCLAIMER

This RFP is a request for proposals only and not an offer document. Answers to this RFP must not be construed as acceptance of an offer or imply the existence of a contract between the parties.
